4. Applicants chosen for the assessment programme will be notified by 30 September 2010 and will be required to send a copy of the full manuscript to the NZSA office for forwarding to an assessor.
5. The assessor’s report and the marked manuscript will be the only feedback eligible under the programme.
6. Assessors will generally send the report no later than two months from the date of receipt.
7. Applications will not be returned.
